

Desert Pea

Floral emblem of South Australia


1 After colouring in your desert pea, fold in half.


2 Fold along the two dashed lines in both directions.







3 Unfold and then fold the top curves in along the dashed lines on both sides







4 Fold top petal section in half and unfold







- Crush fold the top of the flower over the bottom of the flower and open out. It will look like a concertina fold.
- Tape or glue the top petal section onto the main flower body.





Colour the leaves then pinch each of the leaves in. Once they have all been pinched they will be slightly open like the real leaves.





Tape the final flower and leaves together onto a pencil, chop stick or twig.
