Forming Government

The party with the majority of seats in the House of Assembly becomes the Government and leads the Executive.



Representing South Australians

Members of Parliament stand up and speak on behalf of the people they represent.



Approving the Budget

The Parliament must approve the State's budget each year.



Scrutinising Government

Members of Parliament ask Ministers questions to keep them accountable for their work running the Government.



Making Legislation

The Parliament is responsible for making South Australia's laws.
